

Anti-bribery policy

Bribery is illegal and can severely damage the reputation and finances of a company, is a hindrance to trade, restricts competition, and is damaging to society.

- Bribery may be defined as the offering, promising, receiving, or giving of any advantage, whether directly or indirectly, to or from any person as an inducement to carry out an act that is dishonest, illegal, or constitutes a breach of trust in order to obtain or secure an improper business advantage or a reward for such an act. However, bribery can take many forms and if you suspect a situation may involve bribery, that suspicion must be acted upon.
- SEA prohibits bribery in any form by all employees and those working for and/or connected with the business.
- You must immediately report bribery or attempted bribery to your Line Manager/CEO, and you must also do so even if you only suspect bribery or attempted bribery.
